

MN/USA Wrestling Point System Information

MN/USA Wrestling has developed an exciting new program to recognize and better segment wrestlers for the championship tournaments. The program is designed to recognize the performance of Minnesota's wrestlers, based upon points earned in MN/USA and USA Wrestling events.

Included in the point system will be MN/USA Wrestling events in the following age-group divisions: PeeWee, Bantam, Intermediate, Novice, Schoolboy and Girls. In each of these age divisions, specific events in Folkstyle, Freestyle and Greco-Roman will be used to score points.

A few basics about the program:

1. The points will automatically accumulate throughout the season as MN/USA Wrestling events are held. Wrestlers can check on their status by visiting www.MNUSAWrestling.org
2. At the State Qualifier tournaments a wrestler will earn 40 points for 1st place, 25 points for 2nd place and 10 points for 3rd place. A wrestler must compile a minimum of 25 points to qualify for the State Folkstyle Championships. (Pee Wee through Novice only)
3. At the end of the specific style season, the top 10 Pee Wee, 20 Bantam, 25 Intermediate, 30 Novice and 3 Girls will be separated at the State Championships.
4. The Top 5 Girls, Top 10 Youth (includes Pee Wee, Bantam, Intermediate and Novice) and Top 10 Schoolboys will receive a special award at the 2010 MN/USA Wrestling Awards Banquet.

The events which will be utilized for the MN/USA Wrestling Points System in 2009-10 are as follows:

PeeWee (Born 2004-2005)

- All MN/USA Wrestling State Qualifier events.

Bantam (Born 2002-2003)

- Athletes will be ranked at each division for Pee Wee, Bantam, Intermediate, Novice, Schoolboy/girl, Girls.
- Points will be used for separating at all MNUSA Wrestling State Championships. Only those points accumulated in that style will be used for separating purposes at the State tournaments.
 - State Folkstyle: Top 10 Pee Wee, 20 Bantam, 25 Intermediate, 30 Novice and 3 Girls will be separated.
 - State Greco: Top 10 Pee Wee, 20 Bantam, 25 Intermediate, 30 Novice, 35 Schoolboy and 35 Cadets will be separated.
 - State Freestyle: Top 10 Pee Wee, 20 Bantam, 25 Intermediate, 30 Novice, 35 Schoolboy, 35 Cadets and 3 Girls will be separated.
- A Wrestler must compile a minimum of 25 pts to Qualify for the State Folkstyle Championships.
 - This only applies to Pee Wee, Bantam, Intermediate and Novice divisions.
 - Schoolboy and Cadets do not have to qualify for the State Folkstyle tournament and will use the same process as last year for separation.
- Athletes scoring the most points will be given awards and certificates at the completion of the competition year (at the Annual Awards Banquet).
 - Top 5 Girls
 - Top 10 Youth (includes Pee Wee, Bantam, Intermediate and Novice)
 - Top 10 Schoolboys
